WHEREAS, our beloved former First Lady Margaret "Maggie" Corbett Daley, wife of Mayor Richard M. Daley, passed away on November 24, 2011; and

WHEREAS, All of Chicago grieves the loss of Maggie Daley, who gave so much to our great City, and

WHEREAS, Maggie Daley's shining spirit and dignity, her commitment to the city's arts and culture, and her devotion to improving the lives of the city's young people deserves tribute and remembrance; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper that the City honor former First Lady Maggie Daley's memory by setting aside a period of mourning; now, therefore,

I, RAHM EMANUEL, Mayor of the City of Chicago, do hereby order that the official flags be flown at half-mast and that all mourning bunting on City Hall and other City facilities remain on display until Saturday, December 3, 2011.
