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**PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PARKING PERMIT NOW
AVAILABLE AT CITY CLERK'S OFFICE**

*Permit entitles health care providers and real estate professionals
to park business vehicle in zoned areas throughout Chicago.*

Effective March 1, the Professional Service Parking Permit (PSPP) is available for purchase to health care and real estate professionals only at the Chicago City Clerk's office in City Hall. The new permit allows licensed health care workers and real estate professionals to park in any zone of the city without penalty daily from 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. when the permit is displayed on a vehicle used for business purposes. The cost of the PSPP is \$300 and is valid until the last day of February 2008.

In order to purchase the PSPP, applicants must be current and active health care workers or real estate professionals licensed and/or certified in the State of Illinois. More specifically, only real estate professionals including brokers, sales persons and leasing agents, or home health care providers including skilled nurses, social workers, physicians and therapists, are able to obtain the permit. The permit is valid for use on one vehicle being used for business purposes only and the vehicle must weigh 8,000 lbs. or less.

The PSPP is valid in all residential zone parking areas daily from 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with the exception of the Wrigley Field neighborhood permit parking program area. The permit must be displayed on the lower right hand corner of the vehicle's windshield.

Health care workers and real estate professionals interested in obtaining the Professional Service Parking Permit should go to the Office of the City Clerk, Room 107, City Hall, 121 N. LaSalle St. and must bring an original current and active license or certificate issued by the State of Illinois Dept. of Professional Regulations, a valid drivers license or state ID, and a current vehicle registration. A completed and signed PSPP application (available at the City Clerk's office) will also be required.
